Sharing a mutual interest in providing the electrical industry with a highly skilled workforce, the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) Local 134 and the Electrical Contractors' Association (ECA) of the City of Chicago joined forces over fifty years ago to create the Electrical Joint Apprenticeship and Training Trust (EJATT). In turn, the IBEW-NECA Technical Institute (IN-TECH) was established as the premier apprenticeship education center for Local 134 electricians.

Graduates of the IN-TECH program now have the opportunity to continue their education and obtain a bachelor's degree at Illinois Institute of Technology. Towards this end, the IBEW/NECA Tuition Reimbursement Program was created to assist members with tuition costs.

The IBEW/NECA Tuition Reimbursement Program



IN-TECH graduates who wish to take their skills and capabilities to the next level may now transfer into the **Bachelor of Industrial Technology and Management (INTM)** degree program at Illinois Institute of Technology (IIT).

The INTM program is designed to prepare technical specialists for managerial positions in industry. Students may pursue a professional specialization in Manufacturing Technology, Industrial Facilities, or Industrial Logistics. Students obtain a broad knowledge of current technologies and the management capabilities required for a overseeing a range of industrial operations.

Obtaining the INTM degree requires the transfer of 60 credits from an accredited college (as specified in the admission requirements) and completion of 66 credits at IIT, for a total of 126 credits. Most students attend on a part-time basis (taking 2 or 3 courses per semester) and finish the program in about four years.

Program Eligibility

IN-TECH graduates who have been accepted into the INTM degree program may apply for tuition reimbursement. Applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Student must have completed the IN-TECH Apprenticeship Program
- Student must be an IBEW Local 134 member in good standing
- Student must be pursuing the Industrial Facilities specialization
- Student must achieve a grade of "C" or better in the courses taken

Reimbursement Assistance

IBEW/NECA's Tuition Reimbursement Program will cover 50% of tuition costs for a maximum of three courses (9 credit hours) per calendar year. IIT fees, book costs, and other related expenses are the responsibility of the student.

An application is required to initiate program participation. Thereafter, an enrollment form must be submitted at the beginning of each semester for which reimbursement is desired. The student will be notified of the approved reimbursement amount. Upon successful completion of the course(s), eligibility is confirmed and the award credited to the student account.
