*Room and Board

- The Room & Board scholarship will cover the cost the standard double room in the McCormick Student Village. If a cadet elects a more costly housing option, he/she is free to do so but will be held responsible to cover the difference in cost. The Room & Board scholarship also covers the costs of the Unlimited Meal Plan (formally the 19 meal plan).

IIT fraternity or sorority

- Fixed rate scholarship for cadets that elect to live in Greek housing.

In the event that a cadet no longer elects to participate in the ROTC program, the cadet's financial aid will revert to the initial scholarship package offered to the student at the time of his/her admittance to the university.

There are no ROTC scholarship monies for students who wish to study at IIT during the summer term. However, the student's initial scholarship package will be utilized to calculated eligibility under the summer continuation scholarship program.
