

Residency Verification
Dependent
2009-2010

Overview

In order to qualify for a MAP Grant as a dependent student for 2009-2010, the State of Illinois (ISAC) requires that the parent or guardian who completed the FAFSA prove Illinois residency prior to August 24, 2009.

Illinois must be your parent's true, fixed, and permanent home to be considered a resident.

The Illinois Institute of Technology is required to request documentation to verify that you meet this ISAC eligibility criteria.

You must document that your parent was an Illinois resident on the date you submitted the FAFSA.

Only one form of documentation is required. Acceptable documents are listed to the right.

Acceptable Documentation

All documents must be typed on agency letterhead. Handwritten documents are not acceptable.

If you have one of the items listed below, please submit it to the Office of Financial Aid at the address given above. If you do not have any of the items listed, then please call or email the Office of Financial Aid

- Signed and dated copy of your parent's 2008 Illinois State or Federal tax return that shows an Illinois address.
- Parent's Illinois Driver's License.
- Utility bills, rent receipts, residential lease in parent's name, or mortgage statement.
- Parent's Wage and Tax Statements (IRS Form W-2) showing an Illinois address.
- Parent's statement of benefits history from the Illinois Department of Public Aid.
- Parent's statement of benefits form the Illinois Department of Employment Security, or Social Security Administration.
- Parent's State of Illinois identification card issued by the Secretary of State.
- Parent's Illinois property tax bill.
- Parent's Illinois auto registration card.
