\*Room and Board - The ROTC R&B scholarship covers up to the cost of the standard double room in McCormick

Student Village and includes the costs of the 19 Plus Meal Plan, minus any federal Pell or SEOG eligibility. The ROTC R&B Scholarship is available to cadets who live in MSV, Graduate Apartments, or IIT sororities. Cadets who chose to chose a housing/meal plan below the standard amount will receive a scholarship to cover the billed charges only. Cadets who choose to live in State Street Village are not eligible for the ROTC R&B Scholarship. Students who matriculated prior to Spring 2012 are eligible to use their R&B Scholarship towards housing costs in Greek housing at a fixed rate of \$2,588 per semester only.

In the event that a cadet no longer elects to participate in the ROTC program, the cadet's financial aid will revert to the initial scholarship package offered to the student at the time of his/her admittance to the university. There are no ROTC scholarship monies for students who wish to study at IIT during the summer term. However, the student's initial scholarship package will be utilized to calculated eligibility under the summer continuation.
