The position requires a Ph.D. from an APA accredited clinical psychology program. Area of specialization is open. However we are particularly interested in the area of **health**, broadly defined (including pediatric) and the person in this position may be involved in developing a health psychology focus in psychology training at all levels. Faculty activities include establishing an independent research program, research mentoring and providing clinical supervision to clinical Ph.D. students, and teaching at the graduate and undergraduate levels.

The Clinical Psychology Program at IIT is dedicated to a scientist-practitioner model with a balance of research and practice. The College of Psychology has three scientist-practitioner graduate programs, in Clinical, I/O, and Rehabilitation Psychology.
