

CLINICAL PH.D. PROGRAM: 401 Program of Study Instructions

As a degree-seeking graduate student at IIT, you must complete a 401 form in your first Fall semester.

You complete your 401 Program of Study form on the web. As of 07/27/09, go to http://gradweb1.iit.edu/401Forms/grad_e_forms/

Most students will complete the form for a M.S. degree as part of the Clinical Ph.D. program. If you complete a Master's 401 initially, you will complete a Ph.D. 401 after receiving your M.S.

If you are not seeking a M.S. degree as part of the Clinical Ph.D. program (if you earned a Master's degree from another program and completed a Master's thesis which has been approved by your advisor and the DCT) you will fill out the 401 form for a Ph.D. in your first Fall semester.
