

Chinese American Service League (CASL) Scholarship Program

The CASL Scholarships range in value up to \$2,500 per academic year and are awarded to one or two incoming freshmen and/or transfer students at Illinois Institute of Technology. Students with a strong commitment to community service and academic achievement are encouraged to apply. Preference is given to Chinese American students.

Requirements

To apply for a CASL Scholarship you must:

1. Be admitted to IIT as a full-time undergraduate degree-seeking student.
2. Write a one-page essay stating why you would like to be considered for the CASL Scholarship. Included in this essay should be a description of your commitment to community service through past or present projects, as well as highlights of your academic achievements and career goals.
3. Have the above mentioned materials into IIT's Office of Undergraduate Admission by the deadline listed below.

Deadline

*Submit all materials for the CASL Scholarship materials to IIT by **March 1, 2008.***

Required materials checklist:

- Completed freshman application
- ACT or SAT scores
- Teacher/Counselor Evaluation
- High School/College transcripts
- One-page essay

Terms of the Scholarship

To retain the CASL Scholarship you must:

1. Maintain full-time student status.
2. Maintain good academic standing at Illinois Institute of Technology.
