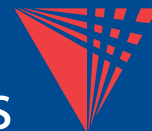

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Students admitted under the **B.S./M.B.A. Stuart School of Business Dual Admission Program (Dual Admission Business)** have guaranteed admission to the M.B.A. Program at Stuart School of Business. Upon completion of a B.S. degree from IIT, students selected into this program may (1) immediately enter the M.B.A. program at Stuart School of Business or (2) defer their admission to Stuart School of Business for a period of up to five years after receiving their B.S. degree. During this time, students are encouraged to gain professional work experience in corporate, public, or a not-for-profit setting. Exposure to the complexities of the business world will add significantly to the overall educational experience once a student enrolls in the full-time M.B.A. program.

ADMISSION GUIDELINES FOR TRANSFER STUDENTS

While each application for the Dual Admission Business program will be reviewed on an individual basis, the following information should serve as a guideline for students considering the program:

1. Students must first apply to and be accepted by the Office of Undergraduate Admission at IIT.
2. Students may complete **any** of the undergraduate degrees at IIT.
3. Students should possess strong quantitative skills as demonstrated by rigorous coursework at the secondary school and community college and university level. While there are no minimum requirements, strong candidates will very likely achieve a cumulative GPA of a 3.5 on a 4.0 scale.
4. The deadline to complete the supplemental application for the Dual Admission Business program is **March 15, 2012**.
5. A telephone or on-campus interview will be scheduled once the Office of Undergraduate Admission receives a completed supplemental application.
6. Once an interview has occurred, students will be notified within one to two weeks regarding their admission to the Dual Admission Business program.

FACTS YOU SHOULD KNOW

Acceptance by Stuart School of Business is automatic for students who meet the following minimum program requirements while an undergraduate at IIT:

1. You must complete your B.S. degree at IIT with a minimum 3.00 cumulative IIT undergraduate GPA.
2. Transfer students must complete their B.S. degree within three years of their first registration at IIT following transfer from a junior/community college or another university.
3. GMAT scores are required for financial aid and used for statistical purposes. GMAT scores are valid for five years.
4. Professional experience is **strongly encouraged** upon completion of the B.S. degree but not required. Although you would gain substantial benefits from obtaining professional experience before undertaking graduate study in business, there are some circumstances that motivate you to go directly from undergraduate school to the M.B.A. program.

2. Why do you wish to pursue study in the B.S./M.B.A. Dual Admission Program, and how are these reasons related to your experiences and interests?
