Recipients of the Presidential Scholarship are strongly encouraged to participate in civic and outreach activities which engage and bridge their communities at the university, in the IIT/Bronzeville neighborhood, and communities throughout the city of Chicago as an essential component of realizing the spirit of the Presidential Scholarship. By April 1 of each academic year in which the student is enrolled at IIT, each Presidential Scholar is asked to submit a one-page, single-spaced summary report of volunteer experiences to the appropriate Presidential Scholarship contacts at IIT. Renewal is dependent on maintaining full-time status and on making satisfactory academic progress.
