As soon as possible	<b>Apply for Housing</b> <hr/> There are many great on-campus housing options. Learn more about each of them and apply for housing at <a href="http://housing.iit.edu">housing.iit.edu</a> .
After March 1	<b>Seek out Financial Aid counseling/Settle Financial Aid</b> <hr/> Review your financial aid package and contact your Financial Aid Officer if you have questions before you arrive on campus in August.
April	<b>Log onto the Orientation website</b> <hr/> Check your mail for Orientation information. Visit <a href="http://orientation.iit.edu">orientation.iit.edu</a> to sign up for your orientation session and start connecting! You'll start receiving emails from your Orientation Counselor (OC) - your personal guide and mentor during Orientation, throughout the year and beyond!
Mid-May	<b>Access your IIT e-mail account and myIIT account</b> <hr/> You will receive a letter with specific instructions on how to access and manage these two essential student accounts. NOTE: If you use another e-mail service provider, please be sure to forward e-mail between your accounts, as messages from IIT will only be sent to your IIT account.
By June 1	<b>Complete placement tests online</b> <hr/> Placement tests must be taken prior to registering for classes. Instructions on placement tests will be available on your myIIT account.
Summer	<b>Consult with your advisor and register for Fall courses</b> <hr/> Instructions for advising and class registration will be included in your orientation materials.
July	<b>Tuition bills mailed</b> <hr/> In early July, start looking for your tuition bill in the mail. You pay your bill when you arrive on campus in August. If you have questions about payment plans or your bill, please contact the Bursar at <b>312.567.3785</b> or <a href="http://enrollment.iit.edu/bursar">enrollment.iit.edu/bursar</a>
Summer	<b>Attend New Student Orientation</b> <hr/> With a whole new orientation setup, you have the option to attend one of six Orientation Sessions. During Orientation, you can take placement exams, meet with your advisor, register for classes, and take your student ID picture. Most importantly, you will get acquainted with the IIT community.
July–August	<b>Purchase books for classes</b> <hr/> You may purchase books at the Barnes & Noble bookstore in the McCormick Tribune Campus Center or online at <a href="http://iit.bkstore.com">iit.bkstore.com</a>
ASAP	<b>Complete immunization and health insurance forms</b> <hr/> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Incoming students born after January 1, 1957 must submit proof of adequate immunizations. To download the immunization form, visit: <a href="http://www.iit.edu/student_health/insurance">www.iit.edu/student_health/insurance</a></li><li>2. Full-time students are required to have health insurance. If you have insurance, you must apply for a waiver of iit's student health plan at <a href="http://www.iit.edu/student_health/insurance">www.iit.edu/student_health/insurance</a></li></ol>
July–August	<b>Receive housing assignment</b> <hr/> Between July and August, you will receive your housing assignment information. This includes: roommate's name and his or her information, room number, room phone number, and your school mailing address (with box number).
August 20	<b>Arrive on campus and start classes</b> <hr/> Move into your new home away from home and enjoy Welcome Week activities! Classes start August 23rd.
