




As soon as possible	<b>Apply for Housing</b>
	There are many great on-campus housing options. Learn more about each of them and apply for housing at <a href="http://housing.iit.edu">housing.iit.edu</a> .
As soon as possible	<b>Visa Appointment</b>
	All students studying on a F-1 or J-1 visa will receive an I-20 from IIT as soon as you have been admitted and have submitted proper financial documents. Once you receive your I-20 you should pay the SEVIS fee and apply for your visa. April	<b>Log onto the Orientation website</b>
	Check your mail for Orientation information. Visit <a href="http://orientation.iit.edu">orientation.iit.edu</a> to sign up for your orientation session and start connecting! You'll start receiving emails from your Orientation Counselor (OC) - your personal guide and mentor during Orientation, throughout the year and beyond!
Mid-May	<b>Access your IIT e-mail account and myIIT account</b>
	You will receive a letter with specific instructions on how to access and manage these two essential student accounts.  NOTE: If you use another e-mail service provider, please be sure to forward e-mail between your accounts, as messages from IIT will only be sent to your IIT account.
By June 1	<b>Complete placement tests online</b>
	Placement tests must be taken prior to registering for classes. Instructions on placement tests will be available on your myIIT account.
Summer	<b>Consult with your advisor and register for Fall courses</b>
	Instructions for advising and class registration will be included in your orientation materials.
July	<b>Tuition bills mailed</b>
	In early July, start looking for your tuition bill in the mail. You pay your bill when you arrive on campus in August. If you have questions about payment plans or your bill, please contact the Bursar at 312.567.3785 or <a href="http://enrollment.iit.edu/bursar">enrollment.iit.edu/bursar</a>
July–August	<b>Purchase books for classes</b>
	You may purchase books at the Barnes & Noble bookstore in the McCormick Tribune Campus Center or online at <a href="http://iit.bkstore.com">iit.bkstore.com</a>
As soon as possible	<b>Complete immunization and health insurance forms</b>
	1. Incoming students born after January 1, 1957 must submit proof of adequate immunizations. To download the immunization form, visit: <a href="http://www.iit.edu/student_health">www.iit.edu/student_health</a> 2. Full-time students are required to have health insurance. If you have insurance, you must apply for a waiver of iit's student health plan at <a href="http://www.iit.edu/student_health/insurance">www.iit.edu/student_health/insurance</a> *Please note that students studying on a J-1 or F-1 visa are not allowed to waive the iit student health insurance.
July–August	<b>Receive housing assignment</b>
	Between July and August, you will receive your housing assignment information. This includes: roommate's name and his or her information, room number, room phone number, and your school mailing address (with box number).
Week of August 17	<b>Arrive on campus, attend Orientation, and start classes</b>
	Get acquainted with the IIT community and take care of business during International Student Orientation. International Students attending Orientation can move in as early as August 17th as long as you are registered for Orientation. Join the rest of your undergraduate classmates for Undergraduate Student Welcome Week prior to the start of classes August 23rd.
