



As soon as possible **Visa Appointment**

All students studying on a F-1 or J-1 visa will receive an I-20 from IIT as soon as you have been admitted and have submitted proper financial documents. Once you receive your I-20 you should pay the SEVIS fee and apply for your visa. Log onto the Orientation website

Check your mail for Orientation information. Visit orientation.iit.edu to sign up for your orientation session and start connecting! You'll start receiving emails from your Orientation Counselor (OC) - your personal guide and mentor during Orientation, throughout the year and beyond!

Access your IIT e-mail account and myIIT account



You will receive a letter with specific instructions on how to access and manage these two essential student accounts.

NOTE: If you use another e-mail service provider, please be sure to forward e-mail between your accounts, as messages from IIT will only be sent to your IIT account.

Complete placement tests online

Placement tests must be taken prior to registering for classes. Instructions on placement tests will be available on your myIIT account.

Consult with your advisor and register for Spring courses

Instructions for advising and class registration will be included in your orientation materials.

Tuition bills mailed

Complete immunization and health insurance forms

1. Incoming students born after January 1, 1957 must submit proof of adequate immunizations. To download the immunization form, visit: www.iit.edu/student_health
 2. Full-time students are required to have health insurance. If you have insurance, you must apply for a waiver of iit's student health plan at www.iit.edu/student_health/insurance
- *Please note that students studying on a J-1 or F-1 visa are not allowed to waive the iit student health insurance.
