

## **B.S. / J.D. Dual Admission Program (law) Illinois Institute of Technology**

Thank you for your interest in Illinois Institute of Technology. Since you have expressed an interest in a legal career, the B.S. / J.D. Dual Admission Program (law) offered by IIT and IIT Chicago-Kent College of Law would be a great choice for you.

You can complete your undergraduate degree and law degree in six years by choosing any of our non-engineering majors with the exception of architecture. Students complete the undergraduate program in three years at IIT and the law degree at Chicago-Kent in three years. Your first year at Chicago-Kent simultaneously counts as your fourth year of undergraduate studies and your first year of law school. If you choose to major in engineering, you will complete one additional year of undergraduate studies at IIT.

In order to be admitted into B.S. / J.D. Dual Admission Program (law), you must apply to IIT as a high school senior and meet the following requirements: minimum GPA of a 3.5 on a 4.0 scale, minimum score of 29 on the ACT or 1280 on the SAT, and be in the top 25% of your class.

The deadline to complete the supplemental application for B.S. / J.D. Dual Admission Program (law) is **Tuesday, January 15, 2008**. A telephone interview or on-campus interview will be scheduled after that date if you are eligible.

Acceptance by Chicago-Kent is automatic for Dual Admission Law students who meet the following minimum program requirements: maintain a 3.25 undergraduate GPA, take the LSAT by February of your third undergraduate year and achieve a score that is equivalent to the average score of Chicago-Kent for the previous year, and submit a completed application to Chicago-Kent by April 15 of the third undergraduate year at IIT (by April 15 of your fourth year for engineering students).
