It is primarily structured to accommodate the needs of the individual participants who represent a wide array of experience and educational backgrounds upon entering the program. The Post Baccalaureate Program is viewed as an opportunity for unsuccessful health and medical professional school applicants or unsuccessful matriculants to continue to pursue their career aspirations.

Each year, an average 20-25 new students are admitted to take qualifying courses for the Chicago Medical School (CMS) Pre-Matriculation Program. Please supply our admissions committee with information that will provide a sense of why you should be admitted ahead of other applicants. - 1) A letter detailing *“why you need”* to participate in a post baccalaureate program
- 2) Include details of any previous attempts to gain admission to medical/dental or other health professional/graduate school.
- 3) If applicable, include details regarding dismissal from medical/dental or other health professional/graduate school.
- 4) Provide all transcripts and test scores (MCAT, DAT, GRE, etc.) completed for entry to professional/graduate school. If applicable, letters of dismissal and your letter of appeal.
- 5) Provide comprehensive and specific contact information, including permanent address, telephone numbers and email address.

You will be contacted by Mr. Bradley for follow-up information, interview, medical school visitation, Pre-Matriculation Program application packet and individualized curriculum plan.
