

## **TO DO LIST FOR PREPARING YOUR LUGGAGE**

**Note:** This list is prepared to give a general idea about what kind of things you should bring.

<b>No</b>	<b>Event</b>	<b>Done?</b>
1-)	Keep in mind that Chicago is really cold most of the year, so bring mostly clothes for cold weather	
2-)	Since in the United States the voltage at the plugs is 110V being different from Turkey which is 220V, check your electrical devices whether they are matching this condition. (To understand it look at the device. 110-220V must be written on it.)	
2.1-)	Don't bring the materials that don't satisfy that condition	
2.2-)	Notebooks generally satisfy this condition, but to be sure double check it.	
3-)	Since in the United States the holes on the plugs are different from Turkey, you need to get a converter or converters to make your connector suitable for that plugs.	
3.1-)	You need to ask stores the converter for the plugs that converts from Turkish to American ( Note: Sometimes it is hard to find it, but be sure that it exists. For people who stays in Ankara, you can only find it in Ulus, at the Bazaar of the Electronic Stores)	
3.2-)	You can use one multiple tap and only one converter for this tap to be able to use your devices.	
4-)	If you don't have a computer, you can buy it from here cheaper than Turkey.	
5-)	Bring your bedsheets, pillowcases, comfortercases if you don't want to make effort on buying them here
