3. Insert your commuter benefits prepaid card number and tap Save.

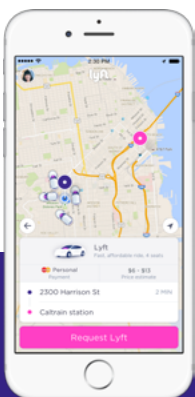
