Register**

1. Identify the course(s) you wish to take and the associated location CRN. Live class sessions are held at IIT's Mies (Main) Campus.
2. Undergraduates must contact the INTM office to have course choices approved and obtain their new 'PIN' (required for registration). Graduate students may look up their registration PIN within the myIIT portal, on the Welcome page under "IIT Personal ID Numbers."
3. To register: Login to the myIIT portal at <http://my.iit.edu>; click on the Registration Dashboard; select 'Register for Classes' link; when prompted, enter your registration PIN; enter CRN number(s) or use the Class Search function to look up and add classes. To waitlist, you must type in CRN to get prompt.
4. A Tuition Deferment Plan is available for students whose employers pay for tuition, and a 3-month payment plan is available to all students for the fall and spring semesters. Apply for a payment plan at the start of each term using the "Manage My Account" system, accessible via the myIIT grid menu.
