1. Portfolio Submission: Submit a portfolio that will serve as both application for scholarship and for provisional credit for INC/ACCEL. View portfolio instructions on the next page.

PLEASE NOTE: The Uncharted Learning scholarship may be awarded under a different name such as "Heald" scholarship. If a student earns multiple Illinois Institute of Technology merit scholarships throughout the admission process, the university will award the highest merit award for which the student is qualified, but will not combine multiple awards. For instance, the Uncharted Learning Scholarship may not be combined with a previously awarded Camras, Collens, University, PTK, Transfer, or International Scholarship.

PORTFOLIO REQUIREMENTS

INCubatoredu students can earn three credit hours for BUS 100 (Introduction to Business). **ACCEratoredu** students can earn three credit hours for BUS 102 (Introduction to Business Analytics) for up to six university credit hours towards an undergraduate degree from the Stuart School of Business at Illinois Tech. This opportunity is open to all students that have completed the **INCubatoredu** or **ACCEratoredu** courses.

Students will submit a comprehensive portfolio for evaluation. Submitting a portfolio is a proven model for holistic assessment. Students will generate a portfolio reflecting their accomplishments in entrepreneurship through their high school experience.

However, please provide a fair amount of personal work and reflection so we can assess your readiness for Illinois Tech. Creativity is encouraged; there is no wrong way to build your portfolio. The best entrepreneurs are creative in all elements of their businesses and lives!

Suggestions to include in your portfolio:

- A completed BMC showing iterations
- Customer Persona & Customer Interview Data
- Positioning Statement
- Financial Model & Financial Story Presentation
- MVP test and results
- Videos during share backs, MVP pitches, year-end investor pitch

ACCEratoredu students should also consider:

- Completed Venture Launch Document
- Data on customers and sales
- Reflection on the legal and banking process
- Videos during investor share back
