GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION

- Only tenured and tenure-track faculty are eligible
- Maximum funding is \$40,000 and each grant will be funded for a maximum of one year, and indirect costs are **not** allowable.
- In the “Sponsor” field, search for “Ram S Ramanujam Prize” and select it as the sponsor.
- Submit your proposal by uploading the final proposal document in the attachments tab in Cayuse. **The deadline for submissions is April 4th, 2025.**
- The Cayuse timestamp of the file upload, not the timestamp of the departmental approval, will be used to determine if the proposal has been submitted on time.
