




Credit for Prior Learning (CPL)

-  **Credit Amount:** Students can earn up to **3 credits (1 specialization course)** for prior learning through professional certificates.
-  **When to Apply:** Submit your certificate ***after* passing PBA courses and *before* graduation.**
-  **Process:** Your application will be reviewed, and a decision will be communicated on approval and which course can be replaced.
-  **Replacement:** **One of the specialization courses** can be replaced with CPL.

How to Check Your Academic Progress: DegreeWorks

What is DegreeWorks?

DegreeWorks is a planning tool to help students (and advisors) monitor student's progress toward degree completion. DegreeWorks provides a more accessible, convenient, and organized way for students to know where they are academically and how they can plan the rest of course registrations.

By using DegreeWorks, you can do the followings:

- View your cumulative GPA
- View in progress, completed, and remaining requirements
- View degree status and graduation status
- View your advisors, program, BA transcript submission status and more



How to Access

Log in to your IIT Portal page.

1. Type "degree works" in the Illinois Tech portal search bar.
2. Choose "Degree Works Graduate"



Graduation Application Process

Degree Conferral

This is when the university officially issues your diploma and confers your degree. This happens **3 times** per year:


- May (Spring graduates)
- August (Summer graduates)
- December (Fall graduates)

Commencement Ceremony

This is the formal, in-person graduation ceremony. This happens **once per year** in May.

Note: The application for degree conferral and the RSVP for Commencement are **separate processes**. You must complete both.


When Should I Apply for Graduation?

- **Spring 2026** Graduation Application is due February 2nd 2026

How to Apply for Graduation (1/2)

Step 1: Access Dashboard

1. Log in to your Illinois Tech Portal.
2. Select the "Students" tab.
3. Click on "Student Dashboard".



How to Apply for Graduation (2/2)

Step 2: Complete Application

Inside your Student Dashboard:

1. Find and click on "Apply to Graduate".
2. Select your **Graduation Term and Program**.
3. Complete and submit your application.

Spring 2026 Application Due: February 2nd, 2026

NOTE: Ensure your personal information is up to date. Diplomas are mailed to the address on file, so it must be accurate.



Commencement Ceremony Details

Who is eligible to walk?

The Commencement ceremony takes place once per academic year in May. Illinois Tech Coursera learners that have completed degree requirements in December, May and August within the academic year are able to take part in the Commencement Ceremony each May.

Fall 2025, Spring 2026, and Summer 2026 graduates are all eligible to walk in the **May 2026 ceremony.**

- Check your university email for the RSVP.
- Order your cap and gown (Due early April).
- Keep checking the official commencement website for updates.




If you are eligible to attend the May commencement...

- Check your **university email** for commencement RSVP email
- Keep checking this website for updated information about **commencement**

- Once you RSVP for the commencement, you will be ordering **cap and gown** (Due early **April**) **<https://www.iit.edu/coursera/degree-student-guide/commencement>**

NOTE:

- Graduates have typically received **four guest tickets**, but this is not guaranteed and depends on the number of graduates and venue capacity.
- Official ticket numbers will be announced in **May**.
- If you need more tickets, you may request extras or trade with other graduates—**do not pay for tickets**


Diploma Details



Check Conferral Date: First, check the Academic Calendar for your official degree conferral date.



Wait Period: It usually takes 2 weeks to 1 month *after* the conferral date for your diploma to be available.




How to Order: Follow instructions on [the Registrar's Office Diploma page](#). This process is managed by Parchment. Please watch for communication from Parchment as well as Illinois Tech!



IMPORTANT: Diplomas will NOT be released if there are any holds on your student account. Clear all holds first.

Your Graduation Checklist

- ➡ **Check Eligibility:** Are you all set? Schedule a meeting with Yumiko Saito or email questions to mba-support@illinoistech.edu.
- ➡ **Apply for Graduation:** Complete the application in your portal before the deadline.
- ➡ **RSVP for Commencement:** Look for the RSVP email from the commencement committee.
- ➡ **Order Your Diploma:** After your degree conferral date, order your official diploma from the Registrar.
