Credit for Prior Learning (CPL)



Credit Amount: Learners can complete 3 credit hours of industry certification that will directly transfer as a course equivalent



When to Apply: Submit your certificate ***after*** passing PBA courses and ***before*** graduation.



Process: Your application will be reviewed, and a decision will be communicated on approval and which course can be replaced.



Replacement: One of the specialization courses can be replaced with CPL.

How to Check Your Academic Progress: DegreeWorks

What is DegreeWorks?

DegreeWorks is a web-based planning tool to help students and advisors monitor student's progress toward degree completion. DegreeWorks provides a more accessible, convenient, and organized way for students to know where they are academically and how they can plan the rest of their college careers. DegreeWorks is not a substitution for consultation with an academic advisor. Students will still need to see an academic advisor in order to receive access to register for classes. Withing DegreeWorks, you can do the followings:

- View your current registrar report.
- Run a "What-If" scenario.
- View E-forms, Request Assistance, & FAQs.

Graduation Application Process

Degree Conferral

This is when the university officially issues your diploma and confers your degree. This happens 3 times per year:


- May
- August
- December

Commencement Ceremony

This is the formal, in-person graduation ceremony. This happens **once per year** in May.

Note: The application for degree conferral and the RSVP for Commencement are **separate processes**. You must complete both.

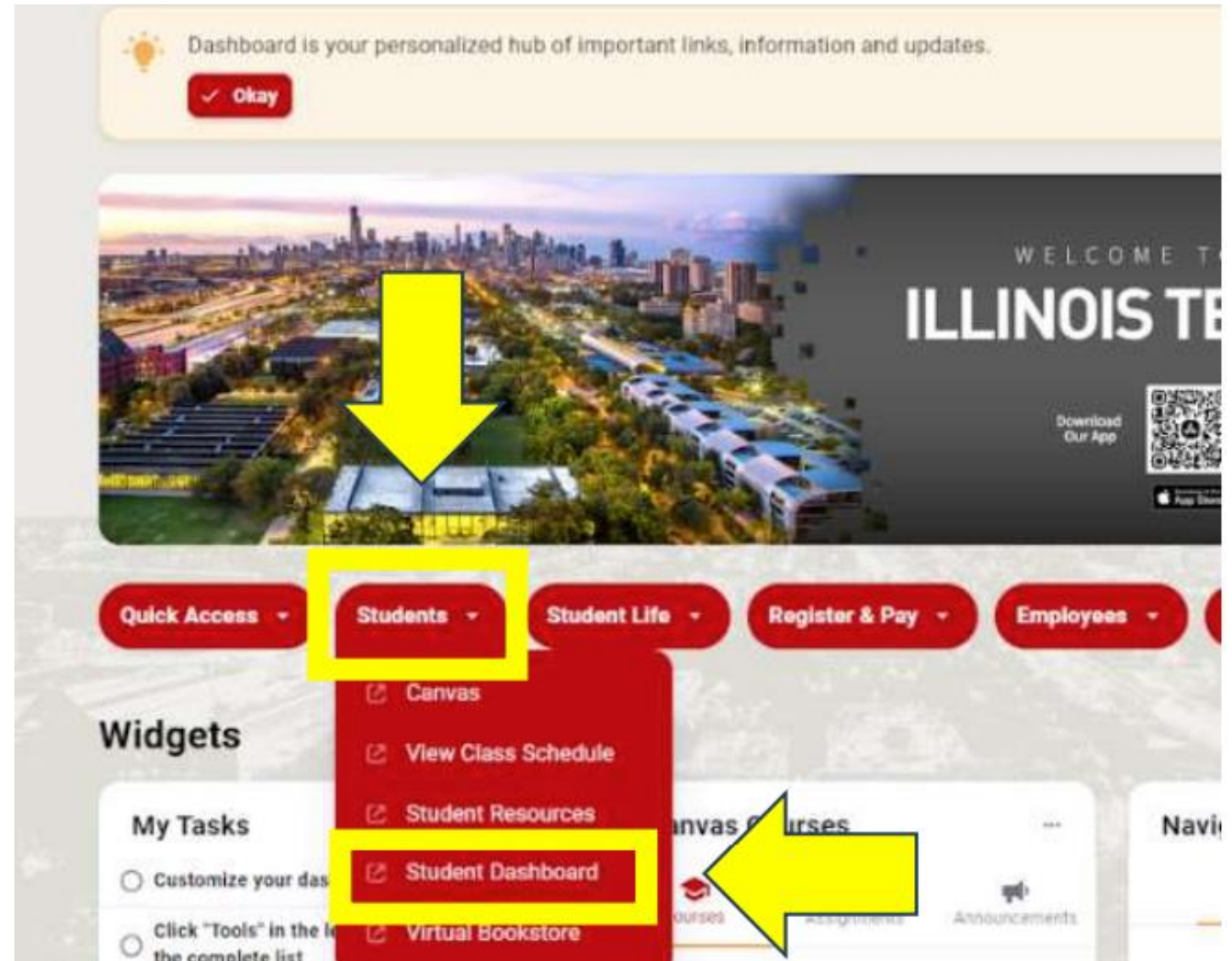

How to Apply for Graduation (1/2)

Step 1: Access Dashboard

- 1 Log in to your Illinois Tech Portal.
- 2 Select the "Students" tab.
- 3 Click on "Student Dashboard".



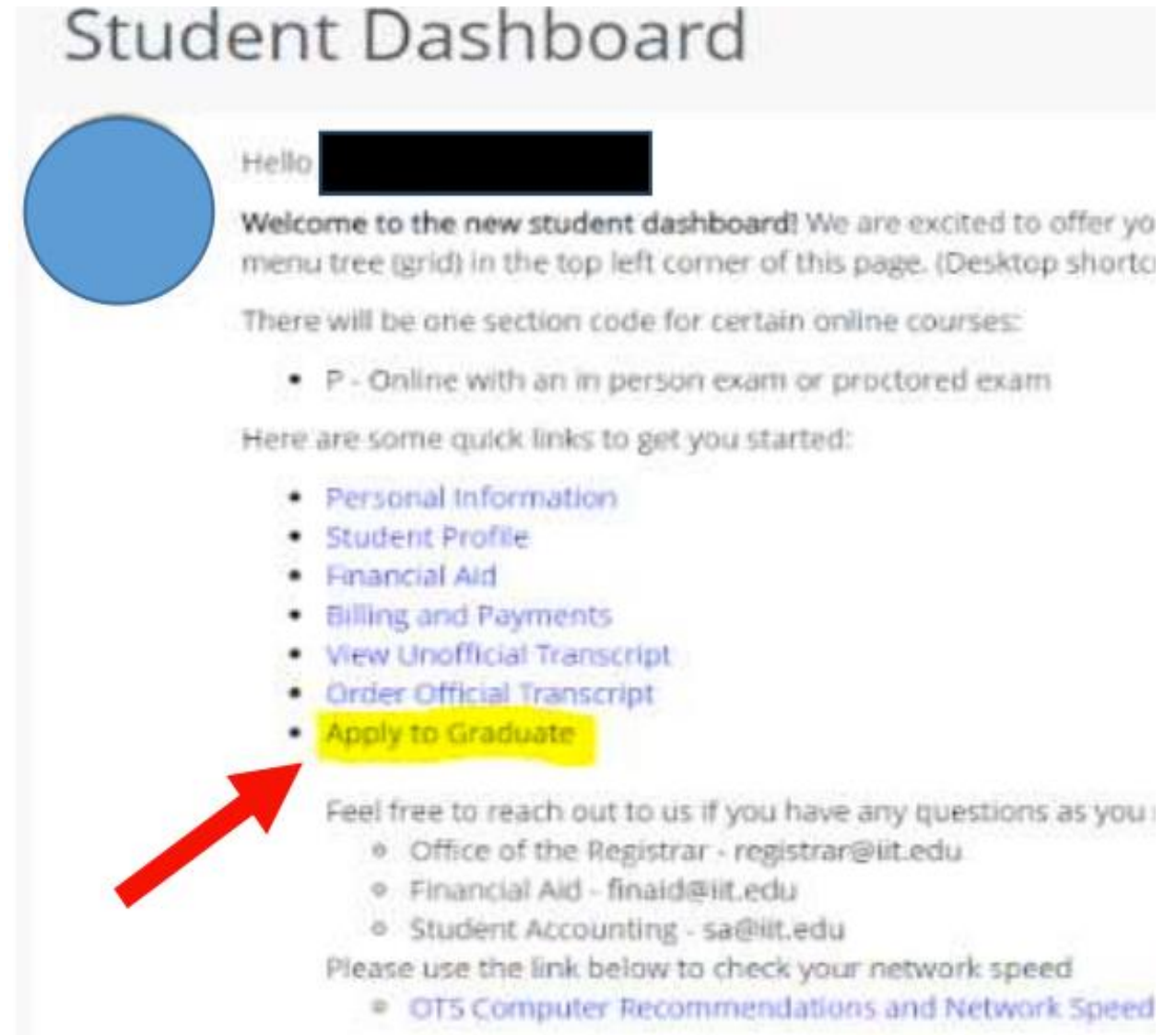
How to Apply for Graduation (2/2)

Step 2: Complete Application

Inside your Student Dashboard:

- 1 Find and click on "Apply to Graduate".
- 2 Select your **Graduation Term** and **Program**.
- 3 Complete and submit your application.

Commencement Ceremony Details

Who is eligible to walk?

The Commencement ceremony takes place once per academic year in May. Illinois Tech Coursera learners that have completed degree requirements in December, May and August within the academic year are able to take part in the Commencement Ceremony each May.

Fall 2025, Spring 2026, and Summer 2026 graduates are all eligible to walk in the **May 2026 ceremony**.

- Check your university email for the RSVP.
- Order your cap and gown (Due early April).
- Keep checking the official commencement website for updates.



NOTE: Historically, graduates have received **four guest tickets**, but please note this number is **not guaranteed** as it strictly depends on the number of graduates and the venue's capacity. The official ticket count will be released in **May**, and if you need more, you are permitted to **request extra or trade** with fellow graduates. **Do not pay** for extra graduation tickets.

If you are eligible to attend the May commencement...





- Check your **university email** for commencement RSVP email
- Keep checking this website for updated information about **commencement** <https://www.iit.edu/commencement>
- Once you RSVP for the commencement, you will be ordering **cap and gown** (Due early **April**)

-  **Order Your Diploma:** After your degree conferral date, order your official diploma from the Registrar.
